Re: Conflict Minerals – Statement of Conformity

Rio Tinto has a sourcing policy and supplier qualification process that encompasses Conflict Minerals. The term “Conflict Minerals” means cassiterite, columbite-tantalite (coltan), gold (Au), wolframite and their derivatives, which are limited to tantalum (Ta), tin (Sn) and tungsten (W).

Rio Tinto’s Aluminium division designates that the metallic products it produces, are from conflict-free mines.

Based on a reasonable country of origin inquiry (“RCOI”), Rio Tinto has no reason to believe that the Conflict Minerals contained in its products originated in the Democratic Republic of the Congo or an adjoining country (“Covered Countries”).
